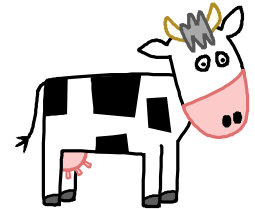

Harvest Festival Friday October 2nd

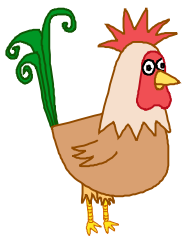
On Friday October 2nd we will be celebrating our annual Harvest Celebration. The children in the KS2 classes will be walking to St Peter's Church. They will be walking in their classes with adult supervision and as always we will enjoy the walk as much as the service! The children in the KS1 classes will be having an assembly in the upper school hall starting at 9:15am. **You are welcome to join the KS1 assembly in the school hall and share Harvest celebrations.** Unfortunately due to space restrictions in the church we cannot invite parents to join us there.
