Dear parents/carers,

Thank you for your support with your children's spelling and reading homework this term. Phonics and spelling are a crucial part of your child's reading and writing development therefore your support at home is extremely important and beneficial.

Attached to this letter are the sounds and tricky words the children have been working on during the autumn term. They will continue to be learning and using these sounds and words throughout the year. It would be helpful for your child to practise them as much as possible at home.

Use the sheets to practise recognising the sounds and to assist your child in reading and writing words and sentences containing the sounds. The tricky words on the sheets are not words that the children can sound out phonetically so they need to practise recognising them by sight. Your child can use all of these words and sounds to practise sentence writing at home, here is an example;

The little brown boat was sailing out to sea.
