Topic

Our topic for this half term is called 'Battle of the Bands'. We will be looking at the history of Music, how it has changed over time and what has influenced these changes. We will also be learning about Sound: how sound is made, how it travels, how we can hear and exploring the patterns in pitch and volume.



Maths

This half term we will be continuing to plot and interpret different types of graphs. We will be developing our understanding of length and finding the perimeter. By the end of this half term we will also start to look at fractions.



English
