**Re: Year Five visit to Stratford-Upon-Avon Friday 16<sup>th</sup> March 2018**

The children in Year Five are being offered the opportunity to visit Stratford-Upon-Avon for the day on **Friday 16<sup>th</sup> March 2018**. The day is part of the Shakespeare Society's open day which invites Warwickshire Schools to visit many of the Stratford landmarks free of charge, so therefore the cost of the visit will only be £6.00 per pupil to cover travel costs by coach. All other activities are free of charge. The coach will leave school shortly after 9:00am and return at 3:00pm. The visit will form part of the school humanities curriculum and the experience will provide a focus for further work back at school as well as enabling the children to have an enjoyable and engaging day out in one of Warwickshire's most famous towns.

The children will spend time in Shakespeare's school room, experiencing a lesson from the school master, they will visit Shakespeare's birthplace museum and the famous guild hall and they will also be following a beautifully illustrated town trail which is set up especially for the day.

The children will be required to wear their school uniform, with a coat and suitable footwear for walking as they will be having a busy day! They will need a packed lunch (no glass bottles or cans please) and, if they wish, a small amount of spending money (around £5). Children entitled to free school meals will be provided with a school packed lunch.
